adolescent mental health, behavior problems, and academic ... - attention problems, delinquency, and substance use with two indicators of academic achievement (high school gpa and highest degree received) with controls for academic aptitude. attention problems, delinquency, and substance use were significantly associated with diminished achievement, but depression was not.
